Students in Cycle 3 will be evaluated in the above subjects. All evaluation takes place over three terms. Each subject includes from one to three competencies. The value of the grades for each term is weighted the same for all subjects: **Term 1-20%**, **Term 2-20%**, **Term 3-60%**. The competencies for each subject are weighted depending on the number and importance of the competencies.

Official Communications

First Communication

By October 12th, 2023, you will receive the first written communication, which will include comments and observations about your child's learning and behavior.

First Report Card

The first report card will be **available on Mozaïk** during the week of **November 20th, 2023**. The report card will cover the period from August 31st, 2023 to November 3rd, 2023 and will count for 20% of the student's final mark.

Second Report Card

The second report card will be **available on Mozaïk** during the week of <u>February 26th, 2024</u>. The report card will cover the period from November 6th, 2024 to February 9th, 2024 and will count for 20% of the student's final mark.

Third Report Card

The third report card will be **available on Mozaïk** prior to <u>July 5th, 2024</u>. It will cover the period from February 12th, 2024 to June 14th, 2024 and will count for 60% of the student's final mark. The final marks for all subjects will be indicated on this report card.

Comments on Learning

On the report card, competency descriptions are only shown for ELA, Math and FSL. This document details in which terms each of the competencies will be evaluated.

For each subject, space is reserved in the report card for the teachers to provide information regarding your child's progress, strengths and challenges.
